Ask for the donation money to be in by a certain day - you can always extend this. Once you've collected the donations send them to Make-A-Wish, remembering to include the completed payment form so we can use this to grant magical wishes straight away. A payment form is included in this pack. If you're fundraising online the money will automatically be transferred to us.
